

POLICE ALERT: FIREWORKS ARE ILLEGAL

The Nassau County Police Department reminds residents that without a permit,

all fireworks are illegal in Nassau County, even if they were purchased outside of the County.







Illegal fireworks can result in property damage and serious or fatal injury.

Speak to your children about the hazards that can occur from handling fireworks.

The possession, use, or sale of fireworks, **including sparklers**, may be punishable as a misdemeanor or felony, monetary fines over \$1,000, and/or time in jail.
