Children will be organized into two age specific sessions. Children entering grades 1-3 will attend the morning session from 10:00 am to 12:30 pm. Youth entering grades 4-6 will attend the afternoon session from 1:30 pm to 4:00 pm. All program activities will be geared to the appropriate age groups.

The Park Field Office will be closed for lunch between the hours of 12:30 pm and 1:30 pm and there will be no supervision available during that time period. Children must be picked up at the end of their session.

Camp Registration will be held at Village Hall on **Friday, June 14, 2024 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.** Please bring a completed registration application for each child being registered, along with **proof of Village residency** (tax bill, utility bill, etc.). If your child has a Village Park ID, you only need to bring the completed application along with their Park ID.

A photo of your child is required (if your child does not have a Village Park ID). Please have a picture of your child available to be emailed to the Village of New Hyde Park that will be used to create a photo ID card for the summer program. If you have more than one child to register, application forms can be obtained at the Village Clerk's Office, or on the Village website at **www.vnhp.org**.

This program is provided free of charge to Village residents for 2024. Non-village residents in the New Hyde Park 11040 zip code are eligible to participate, pending availability. The non-resident registration fee, per child, is \$150.00, which can be paid by <u>cash or check</u>.
